RE: Call for Nominations—CSU Professorship

The CSU Professorship Awards Advisory Committee is pleased to invite nominations of faculty for the title of CSU Professor. Those nominated should meet the qualifications set forth in Article 5.6 of the CSU-BOT/AAUP Contract:

The Board, upon the recommendation of a President and the Chancellor, may award full-time members the title, CSU Professor, provided that the member: 1) has been recommended for the honor by the President who has received the advice of a committee elected from the membership by a procedure designed by the Senate and approved by the President; 2) has been recognized by peers in the field for professional excellence.

Self-nominations, as well as nominations by others, will be considered.

Candidates under consideration will be asked to submit the following supporting materials:

- A letter of application
- A curriculum vitae
- Evidence of peer recognition of professional excellence in their field of endeavor
- Any additional evidence that nominees deem important to the consideration of their application

The Advisory Committee may also request names of references who are willing to provide additional information that will assist the committee in recommending candidates. Outside letters attesting to peer recognition at the national and/or international level would be especially welcome.

Nominations must be submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs, Gelsi-Young Hall, second floor, by **January 5, 2010 at 5 p.m.** Candidates will be notified of their nomination and must turn in supporting materials to the Office of Academic Affairs no later than **January 22, 2010 at 5 p.m.** Members of the Committee are Rita Malenczyk, Professor of English (chair), Michael Adams, Professor of Biology; Michèle Bošković, Professor of French; Anna Kirchmann, Professor of History; and C. Gary Rommel, Professor of Computer Science.
